As I write this letter, Miami is prepping for Halloween and enjoying an unseasonably early (and mild but we'll take it) cold front, a welcome reprieve from a rather punishing summer. It might only be in the mid-60s, but sweaters are out, spirits are up and folks are looking forward to an exciting winter season, ready to embrace everything it has to offer.

If you've been in Miami long enough, you know the start of December means one thing: Basel, that topsy-turvy time of year when the world seems to descend on Miami and creativity and social excess take over. Those seven days known as Art Week (Dec. 4 to 10) are shaping up to be rather memorable, and as you flip through this volume you'll see what I mean. THE FAIR PULSE Miami Beach THE PROGRAM After the closure of the New York edition last year, PULSE Miami Beach becomes even more prominent in its 13th year, which also sees the debut of a new director, Kateljine De Backer (formerly of Aqua and the Armory Show). New exhibitors among the 70 galleries in 2017 include Litvak Contemporary of Tel Aviv, New York's Bernarducci Gallery Chelsea and WHITECONCEPTS from Berlin. Nine artists will again present at PLAY, PULSE's video and new media sector, under the rather felicitous theme of "power." THE FAIR SCOPE Miami Beach THE PROGRAM SCOPE's dominance during Art Week is evident in the numbers: This 17th edition features 130 international exhibitors from 25 countries and 60 cities. But, of course, it's the visuals that make the beach pavilion such a consistent hit. Breeder galleries to watch this year include Portland's Antler Gallery and By Night Gallery from Paris. In special programming, New York-based artist Tom Fruin's Quilt series, composed of drug bags and other debris, and ICON series, a sculptural extension of the quilts, will be on view to destigmatize addiction and, in partnership with Column Health's Craft Guild, raise awareness about treatment. Director Julian Navarro recommends visitors look out for the special performances planned for this year's edition. >>> **Aqua** (Dec. 6-10, \$25-\$95, Aqua Hotel, 1530 Collins Ave., Miami Beach, 800.376.5850, aquaartmiami.com) welcomes a new director, Grela Orihuela, who promises that "the vibe will be fresh and welcoming to all." She's thrilled that Laura Kimpton's 16-foot-tall "Be Art" sculpture will be welcoming guests at the fair's entrance and she's also excited about this year's fashion projects, including "an exhibit from artist and fashion designer Bas Kosters, who believes that fashion transforms. As you wear a garment, you become part of the art," Orihuela explains. A thrilling trio for sure.

THE POWER OF THREE

These fairs may fall under the same ownership umbrella, but each offers visitors something different.

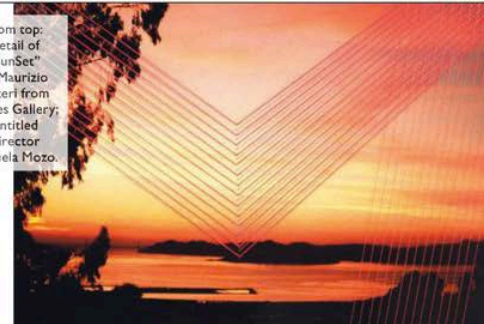
WONDER WOMEN

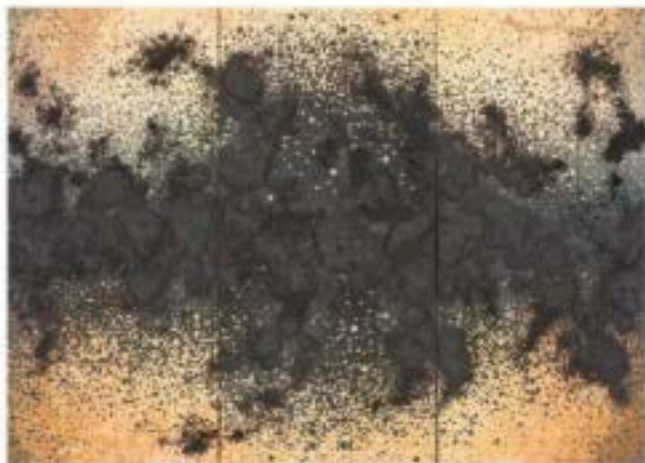

Tattoo Artist Thea Duskin Offers Flash Sessions at Aqua Art Miami

If you've always thought your yoga-toned bod would look that much hotter with an original work of art, this could be your moment. Renowned tattoo artist Thea Duskin will offer Aqua Art Miami attendees the chance to acquire a one-off, single-session tattoo at Ghostprint Gallery December 6 through 10. But you might need to queue up: Priced at \$500, the sessions are first come, first served.

Known for their modern, collagist style, an alternative to the traditional and more familiar black lines and shading, Duskin's tattoos are closer to freeform watercolor paintings on skin. Her technique involves minimal design, drawn without a frame or background, while considering the subject's whole body and contours.

"Contemporary culture seems to be moving in the direction of greater acceptability, and millennials are very comfortable with individual expression and style," says Duskin, who has been creating art on bodies for more than two decades. "There are many more accepted options in fashion and personal adornment, and I have benefitted from this evolving open-mindedness."

Traditionally a boys' club, the tattoo arts have become more open to women in recent years, Duskin says. "As the demographics interested in tattooing broaden and the technology becomes more user-friendly, I believe it can only continue to diversify."

Duskin acknowledges the intimacy and connection involved in tattooing others and has established a close rapport and even some lasting friendships with her clients. “The person being tattooed undergoes stress and pain in the process, and that experience of vulnerability tends to open up opportunity for sharing more personal feelings and experiences,” she affirms. “It wasn't traditionally a rite of passage for nothing.”

Which all means a December traffic frenzy awaits anyone planning on driving, biking, shuttling, walking and water-taxi-ing between Miami Beach and the mainland next week. Much of this traffic will **tangle up the Wynwood art district**, where many white-tented art fairs hold court. Appreciating art is not easy. While artists suffer for their work, art lovers do, too. Art Basel places Miami at the center of the art universe for one feverish week. 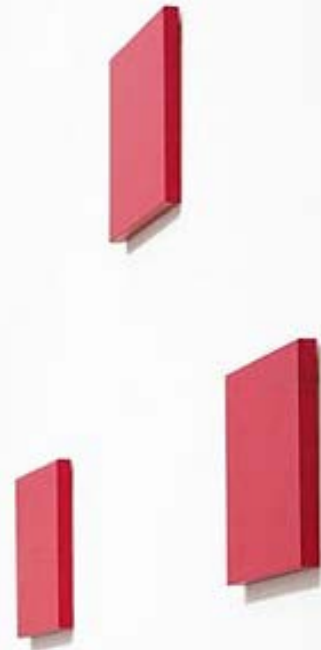

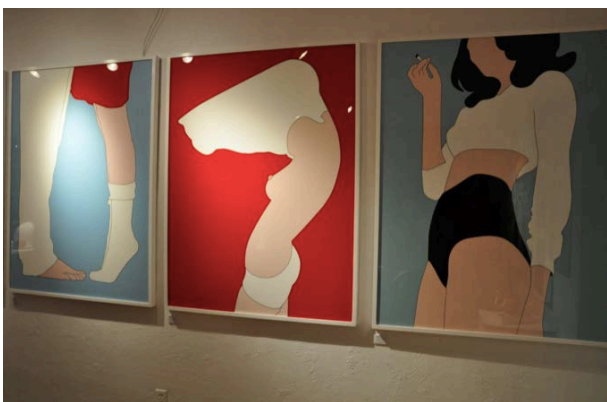

Alfstad& Brings Sarasota Art to Miami Festivals

Sam Alfstad, founder of Alfstad& Contemporary, may not be in the gallery this week, but that doesn't mean he's on vacation. While the gallery has, since its inception, worked to bring national and international artists to Sarasota, this year sees Alfstad and his crew working the festival circuit in an effort to bring Sarasota artists and art to the world. Earlier this year, that meant taking some of Christophe Von Hohenberg's photographs and prints to festivals in New York City, this week it means hitting the road, Miami-bound with prints, paintings and more from 10 of the gallery's artists, for simultaneous exhibitions at the SCOPE Miami Beach 2017 and Aqua Art Miami 2017 art festivals.



"We always want to get Sarasota artists seen in Sarasota," says Alfstad. "This is a way to get them more on the international and national scene." And with yesterday's opening, SCOPE visitors have already marveled at an installation from ribbon artist Anne Patterson and paintings and prints from Sarasota artist Alain Huin and Ringling Professor Michael Wyshock. Throughout the course of the festival, more than 55,000 visitors will join them, not including the 140 exhibitors from 25 countries across the globe. Opening today, the exhibition at Aqua is a bit more expansive, featuring work from nine artists, both local and those who have visited and made work in the Alfstad& printshop. Hosted inside a repurposed old art deco hotel, each exhibitor at Aqua receives its own room in the hotel. Devoid of furniture, they can decorate and arrange the space as they wish. Alongside Wyshock and Huin, fellow local artists Dasha Reich, Mike Solomon and Jorge Blanco show with Alfstad& visitors like Bruna Stude and Zimoun. Alfstad& joins only 51 other international exhibitors in this more intimate, but "funky" and relaxed festival for young and emerging artists and collectors.

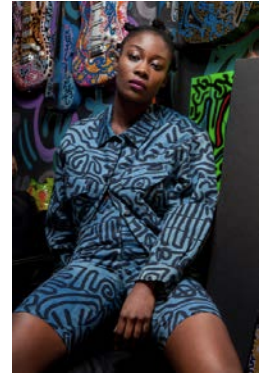
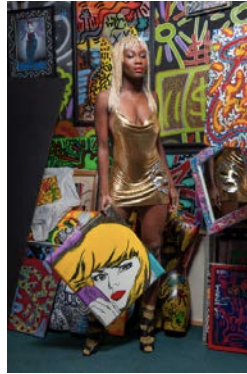
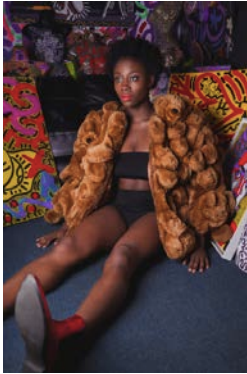

TRAVERSE CITY — Higher Art Gallery and sculptor Rufus Snoddy could boost their profiles when they take to one of the art world's most prestigious events.

The contemporary gallery and its star artist will make their Miami Art Week debut Dec. 5-10. The event — a marathon week of art fairs in Miami and Miami Beach — is known as a destination for the acquisition of important 20th- and 21st-century works. Approximately 1,200 galleries from around the world show thousands of artists during the event, which also focuses on fashion, music and design.

Higher Art Gallery will show Snoddy's work at Aqua Art Miami, one of the best fairs for emerging works. The contemporary art fair inside an art deco hotel will showcase works from more than 47 exhibitors from the U.S.; Montreal; London; Amsterdam; Madrid; Oslo, Norway; Istanbul; Buenos Aires, Argentina; and Tel Aviv, Israel.

"Being at an art fair in December in Miami is a big deal anyway, but there are a handful that are very established, very reliable and very respected — and this is one of them," said Aqua Art Miami Fair Director Grela Orihuela.

"Miami is becoming the new center for art, primarily for contemporary art," said Higher Art Gallery owner and artist Shanny Brooke. "There's so many art galleries, buyers, collectors who are going to look at Rufus' work all at once. The show may take him to the next level."

The fair is a significant undertaking for the Union Street gallery, which opened a year ago and hosted a half-dozen exhibitions. Traditionally galleries pay the way for artists they represent, a cost Higher Art couldn't afford alone.

"It's a large investment so we have an angel investor, a close friend and patron of Rufus," said Brooke, who will attend the fair with life and business partner Pam Johnson, along with Snoddy and nearly 30 of the artist's works.

"I like the idea that they are really going for it and getting a large space for it. It will be beautiful," said Orihuela, whose proposal committee looks at everything from the gallery and its fair history to the artists and presentation it plans to bring before accepting exhibitors. "I think when people walk into that booth they will be engaged and ask questions. The object is to place his work in as many homes in the world as possible."

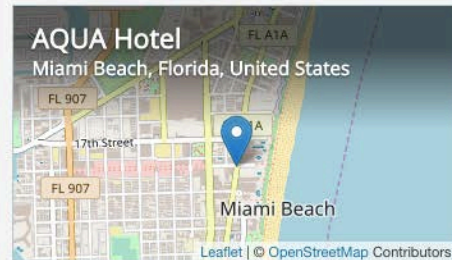

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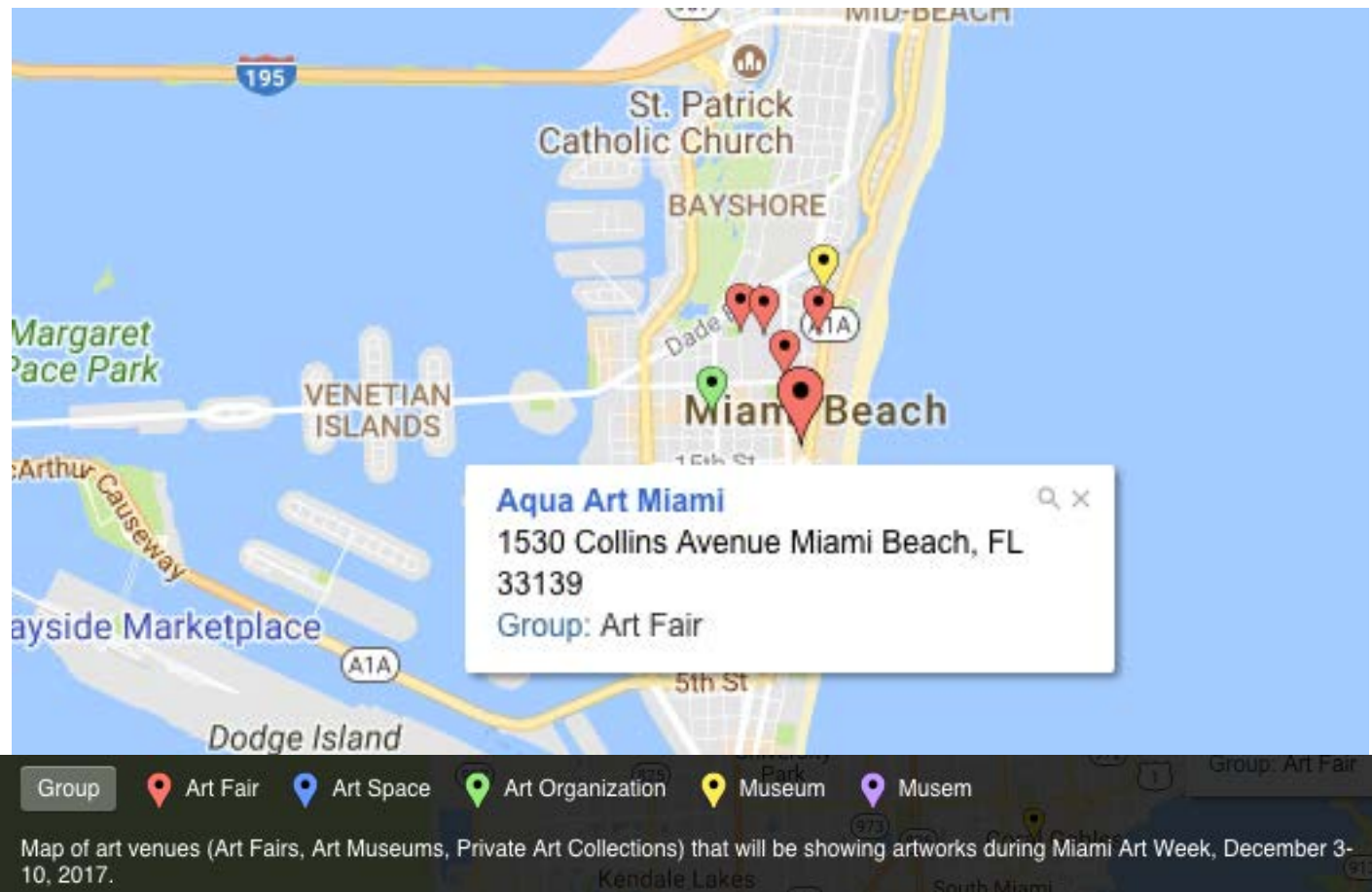

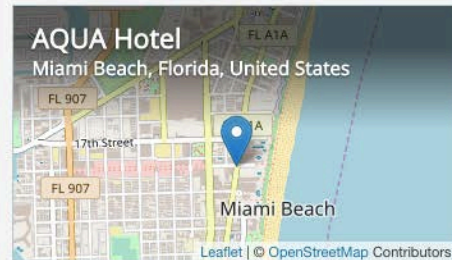

Talk with Art from Canada Artists – Saturday, December 9th at 2pm

On Saturday, December 9th at 2pm, the Consulate General of Canada in Miami and Tranter-Sinni Gallery will host an up-close and personal talk with two artists showing work at AQUA. Jay Bell Red Bird will speak about Canada's aboriginal people – how they once lived, and continue to live, as loving, caring and peaceful people. He will talk about his time spent with Canadian artist Norval Morrisseau, and how great Canadian artists, including his father, Duke Redbird, have influenced his style and technique. Halina Stopyra will then discuss her work from a healing arts perspective, as well as her technique and intrinsic ability to heal through nature, each other and the universe.

AQUA Moments presented by Black Ship (Miami)

AQUA Moments will re-imagine space through sound, architecture, scent and the visual arts to create new environments that engage audiences to identify with all aspects of their surroundings by curation that stimulates and provokes multisensory satisfaction. As part of this program, multimedia performance artist Bea Pernia will provide the musical atmosphere for the VIP Preview.

Artist and fashion designer Bas Kusters believes that fashion transforms, and as you wear a garment you become part of the art. His illustrations, drawings, paintings and graphic designs all work their way into his fashion creations. His work is a warning about alarming social issues by means of dark humor, while endeavoring to create enthusiasm and happiness on the other hand.

"Which Comes First, the Art or the Fashion?" presented by Morphey (New York)

Fashion and art always have been collaborators, and to this end, Morphey presents an art gallery and shop to showcase the ways in which these two worlds coexist through offering the most avant-garde 20th century designers and artists of luxury vintage fashion. The space will feature an installation dedicated to Keith Haring and his Pop Shop, as well as a collaboration with Kara Ross and Unleashed, where three original Bindi works utilizing vintage textiles will celebrate a collective of artisan women from Bareilly, India who are experts in the art of hand beading. These pieces were created through Unleashed's work as a global social impact brand that provides women the opportunity to break the poverty cycle through education and job creation.
